The virtue this week was 'Caring'

Resilience is all about being able to overcome the unexpected.

Research has since established resilience as essential for human thriving, and an ability necessary for the development of healthy, adaptable young people. It's what enables children to emerge from challenging experiences with a positive sense of themselves and their futures. Children who develop resilience are better able to face disappointment, learn from failure, cope with loss, and adapt to change. We recognize resilience in children when we observe their determination, grit, and perseverance to tackle problems and cope with the emotional challenges of school and life.

Resilience is not a genetic trait. It is derived from the ways that children learn to think and act when faced with obstacles large and small. The road to resilience comes first and foremost from children's supportive relationships with parents, teachers, and other caring adults. These relationships become sources of strength when children work through stressful situations and painful emotions. When we help young people cultivate an approach to life that views obstacles as a critical part of success, we help them develop resilience.

The capacity to rebuild and grow from adversity is a key factor in achieving optimal mental and physical health.

Thank you to staff and students for making Term 1 such a fun and productive time. Thank you also to all parents and carers for supporting their children and the school this term. We cannot do this job



PLEASE WAIT INSIDE THE SCHOOL GROUNDS FOR YOUR CHILD

Thank you to everyone, for working together to help keep our children safe when arriving at and leaving school each day.

Please follow these safety measures to:

We ask that the parents and carers who meet their children at the Merriwa St gate, please come into the school grounds when the gates are opened and wait for your children in the flagpole quadrangle. Having groups of adults waiting beside the Children's Crossing makes it harder for drivers to see pedestrians (particularly children) trying to cross the road.

Please park your car and meet your children inside the grounds, or teach your children to use the crossing and walk down to you – never pull up on the other side of the road and let your children run across to the car.

All drivers are required by law to stop at the "Children's Crossing" on Merriwa St when the flags are out, for pedestrians.

Please do not park across our neighbour's driveways, even for a minute.

NEVER stop on the crossing to let your child out – this makes it very unsafe for other children using the crossing (and also attracts a large fine).

Please don't walk through the staff carpark.

Again, thank you for continuing to look after our young pedestrians.

The last day of Term 1 is Friday, 12 April. All children return to school for Term 2 on Tuesday, 30 April. We wish everyone a very safe and happy Autumn school holidays, and hope everyone is able to have some time with their families and friends.
